ELEMENTARY/MIDDLE SCHOOL PROMOTION ACTIVITIES

In order to recognize successful completion of elementary and middle school education, the Board of Education may confer promotion certificates from elementary and middle schools.

(cf. 5127 - Graduation Ceremonies and Activities)

Students shall meet district requirements for promotion based on grades, assessments or other indicators as specified in Board policy and administrative regulation.

(cf. 5121 - Grades/Evaluation of Student Achievement) (cf. 5123 - Promotion/Acceleration/Retention) (cf. 6162.5 - Student Assessment)

Schools must coordinate the timing of their end-of-year promotion activities so parents with children being promoted from schools at several levels do not have a conflict. Changes to the schedule outlined below must be worked out in advance with other cluster/feeder schools.

* K8/Middle Schools at or after 7:30 a.m., to end no later

than 10:30 a.m.

* Elementary Schools at or after 11 a.m., to end no later than

12:30 p.m.

* Senior High Schools Graduation Ceremonies at or after 1 p.m.

All promotion exercises for students on traditional or year-round schedules **must be held** on the last day of student attendance.
