**Brief Explanation:**

For more than 14 years, San Diego City Schools has maintained a cooperative agreement with the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC), Division of Adolescent and School Health (DASH). This partnership between the CDC and SDCS fosters coordinated school health education for youth. As part of our cooperative agreement, every other year we conduct surveys of Principals and Lead Health Teachers to assess the status of school health education at the middle/junior high and senior high school levels. The data collected and presented as the School Health Profile will be used to improve the delivery of health education to our students.

Individual responses will be kept confidential, and at no time will the school or community be identified. Questionnaires will be sent to school sites by February 1, 2006. Completed questionnaires are due in the Physical Education, Health and Athletics Office by March 1, 2006.
