Action Requested: Return testing materials used for placement in literacy and mathematics courses, including all District Mathematics Tests (DMT), and Mathematics Diagnostic Testing Project (MDTP) Algebra Readiness and Geometry Readiness Tests to the District Assessment Department.

At the beginning of this school year, testing materials were delivered to all middle, junior high, senior high, and selected atypical schools in the form of a kit to use when testing 1) students new to the district or 2) returning students who for some reason had no reading or mathematics placement test scores. The materials in the kits included District Mathematics Tests (DMT), Mathematics Diagnostic Testing Project (MDTP) Algebra Readiness Tests and Geometry Readiness Tests, answer sheets, answer keys, scoring templates, and placement guidelines. All materials were in black plastic file boxes (11 x 10 x 12 inches) with instructions to keep in a secured location and to use the materials for placement purposes throughout the year. Most often, these materials were kept in the counseling center either by the head counselor or the counseling secretary.
