**Subject:** GRADES 9-12 SUFFICIENCY OF INSTRUCTIONAL MATERIALS FOR 2006-2007 SCHOOL YEAR AND COMPLIANCE WITH WILLIAMS LEGISLATION

**Reference:** Education Code 60119, Board Policy F-5000, District Procedures 4500, 4505, and 4520

**Action Requested:** Complete attached Sufficiency Survey and return to Instruction and Curriculum, Instructional Materials Department, Education Center, Room 2110.

**Brief Explanation:**

In accordance with Education Code 60119, each school district's governing board must hold a public hearing no later than the eighth week of the school year to determine, through a resolution, whether each pupil in the district has sufficient textbooks or instructional materials, or both in the following subjects: mathematics, science, history-social science, and English/language arts. The governing board must also determine whether each student enrolled in a foreign language or health course has been provided sufficient textbooks or instructional materials. According to Williams Legislation, sufficient textbooks or instructional materials means that each pupil, including English learners, has a district-adopted textbook or instructional materials, or both, to use in class and to take home.

To ensure your school is sufficient in the fall and meets the requirements of the Williams Legislation, it is important that you complete the attached "Instructional Materials Sufficiency Survey" which includes course numbers and titles as well as the materials adopted for the course. Space is provided at the end to enter any site-adopted courses in mathematics, science, history-social science, and English/language arts that are not included in the survey. The columns headed "Number of Students Projected," "Number of Textbooks on Hand," and "Number of Textbooks Ordered" should be completed as a part of your year-end closing activities and planning tool.

The remaining columns must be completed in the fall using actual student enrollment numbers and textbooks issued as of **Tuesday, September 19**. Each principal must sign the survey and return it on **September 20 via fax (619-725-7242)**. **In addition, please put the original, signed copy in the school mail addressed to Room 2110, Education Center.**
